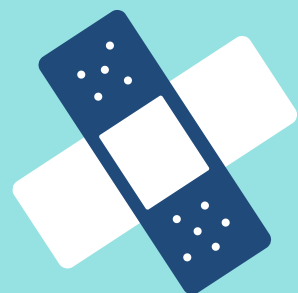


3W Medical for Women is committed to keeping our patients, staff and community safe. Here are some recommendations to help limit the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19).

- Fever, coughing, shortness of breath, congestion, sore throat
- Been exposed to someone who have these symptoms
- Been tested positive for COVID-19
- Have traveled to China, Iran, S. Korea, Europe
- Please give us a call to reschedule your appointment.



2 IF YOU'RE SICK BUT STILL NEED SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTHCARE

- We will remain open until further notice. We are limiting our services to STI Testing & Treatment and Pregnancy Verification.
- Preventative & routine screening such as Pap Smears will be postponed until May.



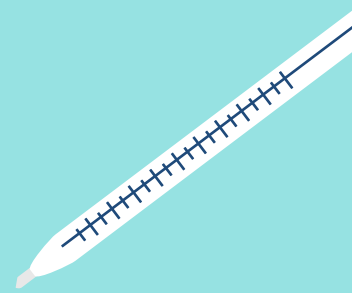
3 3W CLINIC - THE MEASURES WE'RE TAKING:

- Our clinic space is being thoroughly cleaned on a daily bases.
- Under 10 people in the clinic space at any given time. This includes our staff, volunteers and patients.
- We're removing all magazines in our waiting areas and sanitizing all frequently touched items several times a day.
- Tissues, masks, and hand sanitizers are available throughout the clinic.
- We're not shaking hands.
- We're practicing social distancing and staying at least 6 ft. away from people.
- Our Licensed healthcare providers may be wearing additional gloves, gowns, or masks during your visit.
- We are asking all staff who are sick to stay at home.
